To Whom It May Concern:

In the summer of 2002, the City of Brighton was faced with repairing or replacing approximately 200 feet of an elliptically shaped 16" RCP pipe underneath a major highway. The pipe had not been used for several years and after extensive cleaning the pipe was found to be rusted and deteriorated at both ends.

After seeing a demonstration and obtaining the technical specifications on the *Poly-Triplex Liner System*, the City of Brighton chose to repair the pipe with the *PTLS-6800 liner*. Although the liner cost is greater than the traditional sliplining, the liner offered the strength necessary to support the integrity of the roadway without losing the capacity in the pipe.

The contract to installed the liner was with a local contractor, but we were pleased with the personal attention that Poly-Triplex International gave to our project. It has only been a short time since the liner has been installed, and we have not had any problems to date. With the 10-year warranty, we anticipate this to be the case for a long time to come.
